① Japan

Tetsuya Shimomura (Director of International Affairs Office, Housing Bureau, Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT))

He joined the Ministry of Construction (currently MLIT), Japan in 1994. So far, he has worked in the field of housing, building and urban planning in MLIT (Housing Bureau, City Bureau, Policy Bureau, etc.), Cabinet Secretariat, Kyoto City, OECD (Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development), FNMA (Federal National Mortgage Association, the US), etc. He has been in his current position since July 2021.



② China

Dawei Li (Division chief, Research Institute of Standards and Norms (RISN), Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development (MOHURD))

RISN is an authority research management institute of construction field in China. Dawei Li is division chief of Construction Engineering Standards Department of RISN and has been engaged in the technical standards for construction for a long time. He has made a thorough study of the standardization of engineering construction. He has organized and conducted research of "Study on the Influence of Engineering Construction Standards on National Economy and Social Development".

Taweethong Wichaidit started work at Director - Office of Community - Based Tourism, Bangkok in 2010 and he moved on Managing Director - Designated Areas for Sustainable Tourism Administration (Area 3 Pattaya City and Vicinity) in 2012 and He was promoted to Deputy-Director General (Assistant Secretary to DASTA Executive Board) - Designated Areas for Sustainable Tourism Administration in 2015 and then in 2019, He was gotten the Board of Director - National Housing Authority, Bangkok and he has been selected as the Governor - National Housing Authority in 2020 until now in Bangkok, Thailand.
